Informações gerais:

Até **20 de Março de 2026**, estarão abertas as inscrições internas para a seleção de estudantes interessados em participar do intercâmbio na Espanha, *Universidad Politécnica de Madrid*. O intercâmbio tem previsão de início **em agosto de 2026 e término em fevereiro de 2027**. Aulas oferecidas em inglês ou espanhol.

Pré-Requisitos:

Os pré-requisitos gerais para participar dos programas de intercâmbio são:

Art. 92. A participação do estudante em programas de intercâmbio é condicionada ao atendimento dos seguintes requisitos no momento da inscrição:

- I. Estar regularmente matriculado; e,
- II. Ter sido aprovado em todas as disciplinas do primeiro e do segundo períodos (P1 e P2) de seu curso; e,
- III. Apresentar a mediana de todas as notas das disciplinas cursadas igual ou superior a 60 (sessenta); e,
- IV. Ter plano de atividades acadêmicas, a serem cumpridas na instituição anfitriã, aprovado pelo coordenador de seu curso de origem; e,
- V. Apresentar exame de proficiência do idioma exigido pela instituição anfitriã; e,
- VI. Estar em dia com todas as obrigações financeiras junto ao Inatel.
- VII. Ter sido aprovado na avaliação realizada pelo Núcleo de Orientação Educacional.

É de responsabilidade exclusiva do estudante estar ciente e atender a todos os pré-requisitos exigidos tanto pela instituição anfitriã quanto pelo Inatel.

Regulamento e critérios de classificação

O aluno deve ler atentamente e estar em conformidade com o **Regulamento Geral dos Cursos de Graduação** do Inatel, especificamente com o Capítulo III, Seção V – Mobilidade Acadêmica, que estabelece os critérios para a participação em programas de intercâmbio promovidos pela instituição, e com o Capítulo V, Seções VI e VII, que tratam da Equivalência de Atividades Acadêmicas e Aproveitamento de Disciplinas.

Benefícios e responsabilidades financeiras

I - O estudante estará isento do pagamento de mensalidades no Inatel e na instituição anfitriã durante o período de intercâmbio, desde que esteja matriculado em programa de mobilidade acadêmica. Cabe ao estudante verificar e cumprir as condições necessárias para a manutenção da isenção na universidade anfitriã.

II - Conforme disposto no Art. 103, Capítulo III, Seção V: As despesas com passagens, alojamento, manutenção, livros, material e taxas acadêmicas, seguro de saúde internacional, traduções de documentos, visto e qualquer tipo de trâmite ou gasto pessoal relacionado com a participação no programa de intercâmbio são de responsabilidade do estudante participante, salvo quando o edital indique o contrário.

No caso de número restrito de vagas na universidade anfitriã, o procedimento será de acordo com o Art. 94 do Capítulo III, seção V do Regulamento Geral dos Cursos:

Art. 94. As candidaturas para o intercâmbio serão analisadas pelo NESP que fará uma

classificação das solicitações apresentadas obedecendo aos seguintes critérios:

- I. A faixa de CRE, assim consideradas: $CRE \geq 90$; $85 \leq CRE < 90$; $80 \leq CRE < 85$; $75 \leq CRE < 80$; $70 \leq CRE < 75$; $65 \leq CRE < 70$; $60 \leq CRE < 65$ e $CRE < 60$.
- II. Em caso de empate no item acima terão prioridades os estudantes que ainda não tenham participado de intercâmbio com apoio institucional.
- III. Persistindo o empate será considerado o estudante que tiver cumprido o maior percentual do número de créditos do seu curso.
- IV. Ainda persistindo o empate será considerado o maior CRE.

No certificate is requested for exchange students. By signing the learning agreement, the home University guarantees that the nominated student has the required language level. However, a language certificate may be requested in order to guarantee the academic performance of the students.

Estimated cost of living

ACCOMODATION

Shared flat in Madrid: prices range between 500€ and 800€ for a single room, depending on the location.

Student residences on campus are available for exchange students and include room cleaning service, dinner, gym, cultural activities and sport facilities such as swimming pool (prices range between 900€ and 1200€/month).

Student guide for accommodation available.

TRANSPORT

If you are under 26 years old, you can get a monthly ticket for 10€ and you can use it as many times as you want in the whole Community of Madrid. It works for both bus and metro.

FOOD

The average food cost might be around 250-300€/month.

WELCOME DAY

At the beginning of each semester, the international office of ETSIT organizes a welcome day for all incoming students.
