The abstract length must have at least 1,000 words and should not exceed three pages. The text must present the aim of the paper and its main contributions. Presentation of partial or initial results is encouraged. Fell free to include figures, tables and equations if you think that it will help the reviewers to understand the objectives and results of your work. It is also important to list the main references of your paper. Please, use the IEEE format [1].
